On March 23, 2010, President Obama signed into law the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act. On March 30, 2010, the Health Care and Education Reconciliation Act of 2010, which amended the March 23rd Act, was signed into law. Together, these two acts are referred to as "PPACA."
